

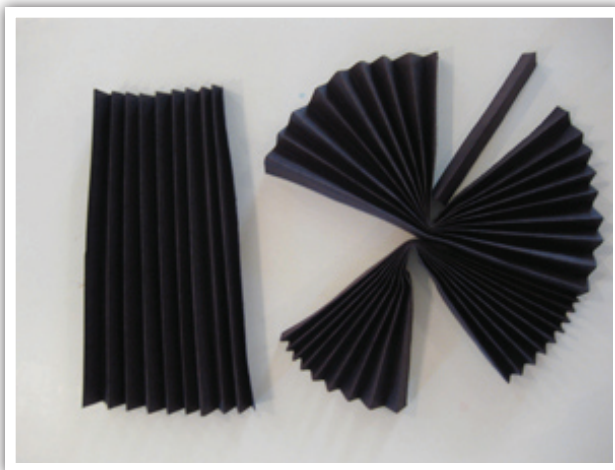
Halloween Decorations



What you will need:

- 3- 8 ½ by 11 inch sheets of orange construction paper
- 3- 8 ½ by 11 inch sheets of black construction paper
- Scraps of orange, green, white and black construction paper
- Hot glue gun
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Ribbon
- Clothes pins (not necessary, but helpful)

How to do it:



1. Fold Paper-for each decoration you will need to fold 3 pieces of 8 ½ by 11 inch construction paper. Accordion fold each sheet making ½ inch to ¾ inch folds. Then bend each in half to make a fan. You can make bigger decorations using more sheets of paper.

2. Form Circles-cut 6 strips of paper equal to the length of the fan's fold and twice its width. Then fold in half lengthwise. Glue the strips to the fan (see picture). Now glue the fans together to form a circle. This part was a little tricky. I did this without my 2 ½ year old and then let him help me decorate them. I also used clothes pins to keep the fans together until the glue dried.

3. Add Features-now add some faces, stems, etc. using hot glue. Be sure to decorate both sides, if they aren't hung against a wall you will see both sides. You can also use glitter, paint or markers to decorate. Then punch a hole in the top and hang with a ribbon. You can make a bunch of these and hang them over a table.
